We received 69 responses out of a total of 86 St George's families. This is an 80% response rate which gives us a very good indication of parent perception.

Teachers and support staff work hard to give each pupil the best support possible, within our limited resources, and it is important for them to know that this is recognised.

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

We currently have 19 pupils on our Special Educational Needs and Disabilities register. This is 16.5% of the pupil population which is some way above the national average of 12.6%. Our SEND pupils have a wide variety of needs and the support given in school varies according to need.

Six families responded to the SEND section of the survey; due to the small numbers I have included numbers of responses as well as percentages.
