# Read, Write, Inc Phonics

- At St George's we follow the Read, Write, Inc programme which was developed by Ruth Miskin. Read Write Inc Phonics teaches children to read accurately and fluently with good comprehension. They learn to form each letter, spell correctly, and compose their ideas step-by-step.
- Our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children all take part in 30 minute sessions at the beginning of every school day from 9.00-9.30am. All children are assessed every 6 weeks to ensure they are working within the correct group to match their phonic knowledge. Children continue to push through the different levelled groups until they reach the end of the Read, Write, Inc programme.
- Our school reading scheme matches the children's phonic level and follows the Read, Write, Inc programme.
- We have a consistent approach between YR, Y1 and Y2 that supports all of our readers.

# Set 1 Sounds



- If your child is still learning to blend and recognise set 1 sounds they will take home a sound blending book once a week.
- Once your child can blend a range of sounds confidently they are assessed and can then progress onto Red Ditty Books. If your child is in this group they will take home two books at this level on a Monday and Friday.

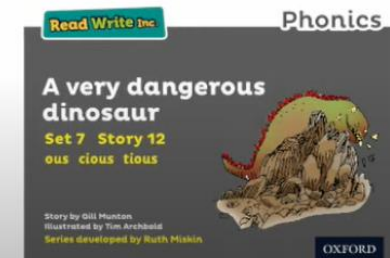
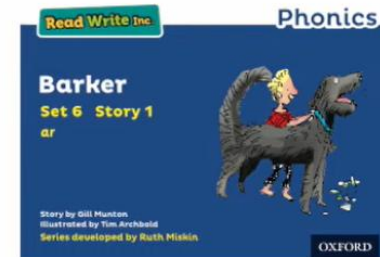

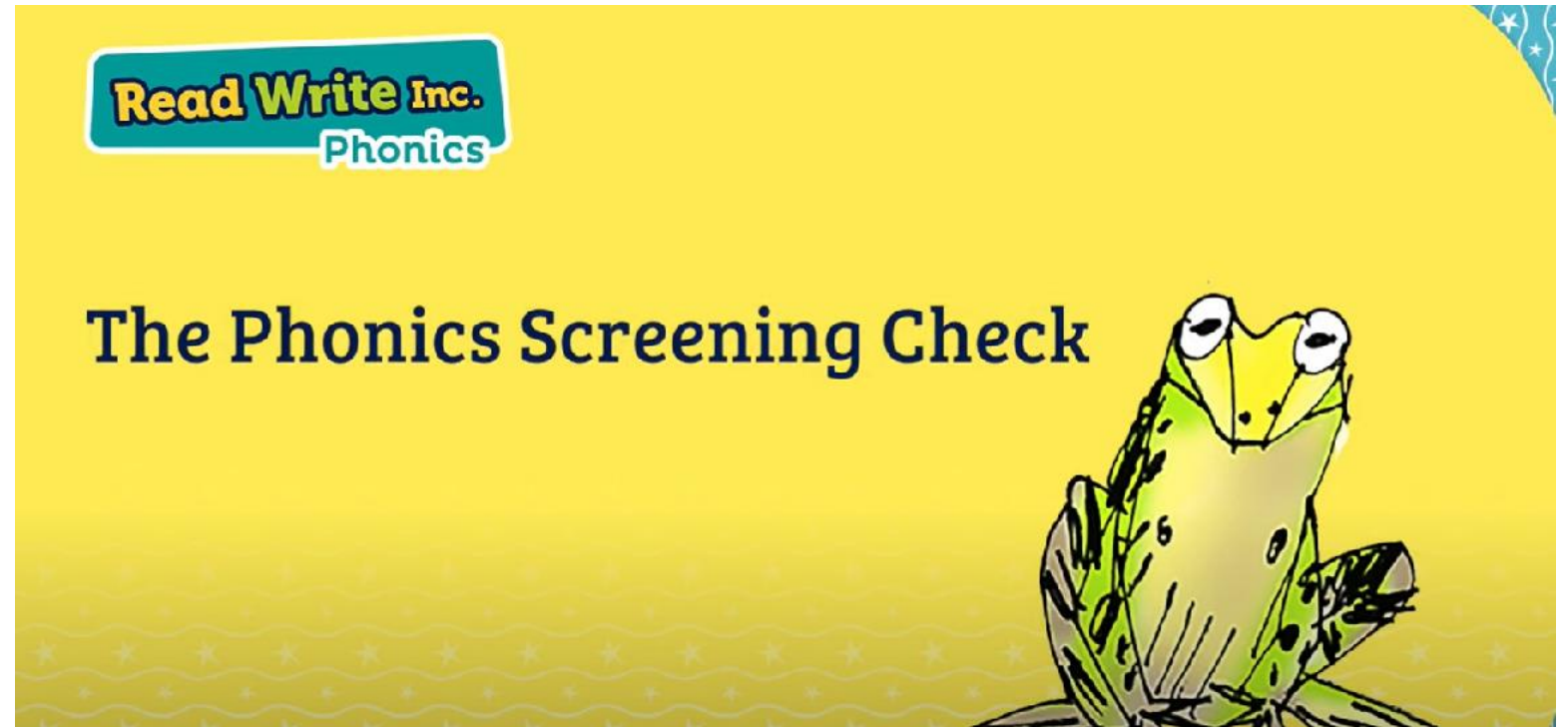

## Oxford Level 8

At Level 8, children are generally more confident in their reading and know most common, non-decodable tricky words. Level 8 stories are often split into chapters. Your child is likely to enjoy choosing which books to read, often reading some of the text in order to help them decide.

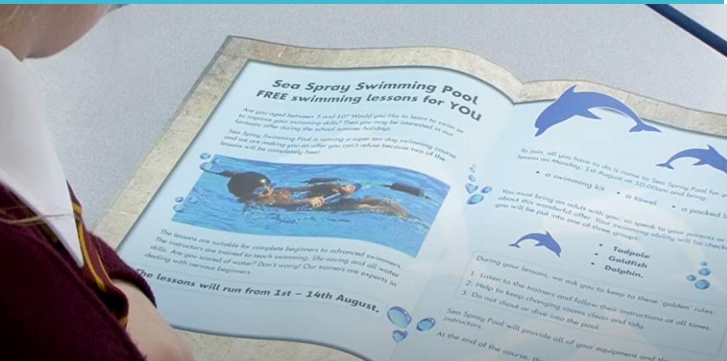

# Preparation for KS1 SATS Reading Paper

## Year 2



**KS1 SATS Reading Test** – Consists of two papers

A range of age appropriate texts are included from fiction, non-fiction or poetry.

The children read the texts and answer questions about them.

They are not strictly timed but typically pupils take 30 minutes to complete paper one and 40 minutes to complete paper two.

They do not sit the two reading tests on the same day.

These tests are completed throughout May.
